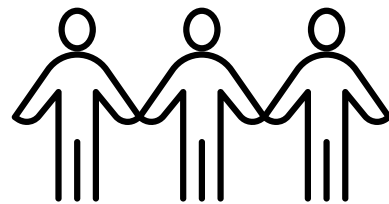
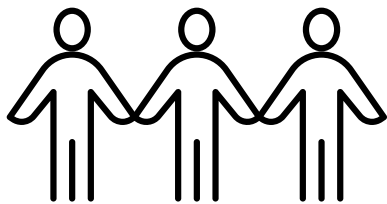

PROGRAMS AND INITIATIVES BY SRRO

FREE HEALTH EDUCATION FOR LEPROSY PATIENT AND THE TRIBALS (RUNNING A VENTURE NAMED SAKSHAM IN 2013-2014)

In 2013–2014, Social Reforms and Research Organization (SRRO) launched a dedicated venture named 'Saksham' with the aim of spreading free health education among leprosy patients and tribal communities, particularly in the Tahirpur region of Delhi. This initiative was designed to uplift the marginalized by promoting awareness about hygiene, nutrition, and basic healthcare practices. Alongside educational outreach, SRRO also organized free health camps and cloth distribution drives to address the immediate needs of these vulnerable groups. To support the holistic development of tribal children, the program provided monthly stipends, conducted painting competitions, tree plantation drives, and arranged motivational sessions by experienced orators, helping children connect with nature and develop confidence. The Saksham initiative became a model of inclusive development, blending education, environment, and empathy for lasting social impact.



INTERNATIONAL WOMEN'S DAY (MARCH-2014) NATIONAL SEMINAR ON "SAVE GIRL CHILD: THE CHANGING PROSPECTIVE IN INDIA"
