

SRRO MEMBERSHIP CAMPAIGN

Invitation for Short-Term Membership

Social Reforms and Research Organisation (SRRO) invites applications for Short-Term Membership. Since its establishment in 2013, SRRO has worked continuously with dedication for social welfare and has built its credibility as a service-oriented organisation. This membership initiative is intended to connect genuine individuals who wish to contribute actively towards society and participate in SRRO initiatives.

Membership Category

SRRO invites applications for Short-Term Membership. This membership will be valid for one year. During this period, the member's active participation, social awareness, dedication, commitment towards the organisation, and involvement in SRRO's social initiatives, programmes and campaigns will be assessed.

After completion of one year, the SRRO team will review the member's contribution and participation. Further membership will be considered on the basis of this review.

Membership Types After One Year

1. Active Member

This membership will be valid for five years. Priority will be given to deserving members who have completed their Short-Term Membership successfully. With the permission of the President, credible and deserving individuals may also be granted membership directly. Honorary Membership may be granted to respected and distinguished personalities of society.

2. General Member

Members who complete their Short-Term Membership may be offered permanent membership according to their interest and eligibility.

Membership Duration

- Short-Term Membership: One Year
- Active Membership: Five Years
- General Membership: Ten Years

Eligibility Criteria

- The applicant must be a citizen of India.
- The applicant should not have any criminal record.
- The applicant must submit a copy of their Aadhaar Card from both sides.

Instructions

1. The applicant must confirm their willingness to join and commit to active participation.
2. The applicant must provide consent to receive information, updates and communication through mobile calls and messages.

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3. Applicants are encouraged to mention their areas of interest and preferred contribution areas.
4. The name, work or identity of SRRO cannot be used for personal purposes without prior permission from the organisation.
5. If any member is found involved in criminal activities or anti-social activities, the organisation may terminate their membership immediately.
6. If any member gives statements against the organisation or is found involved in activities against SRRO, a notice will be issued. If a satisfactory reply is not received within five days, the member may be removed from the organisation.
7. Any dispute should first be raised officially within the organisation instead of being directly taken to court.
8. All work and decisions will be carried out through mutual consent. In case consensus is not reached, the decision of the governing committee will be final.
9. No identity card or certificate will be issued to members.

Age Limit

- Male: 18 to 55 years
- Female: 20 to 50 years
- Transgender: 25 to 50 years

Special Preference for Students

- Preference will be given to students studying in colleges and educational institutions.
- Students may use this membership initiative as an opportunity to contribute through research, social awareness activities and writing blogs related to social welfare.
